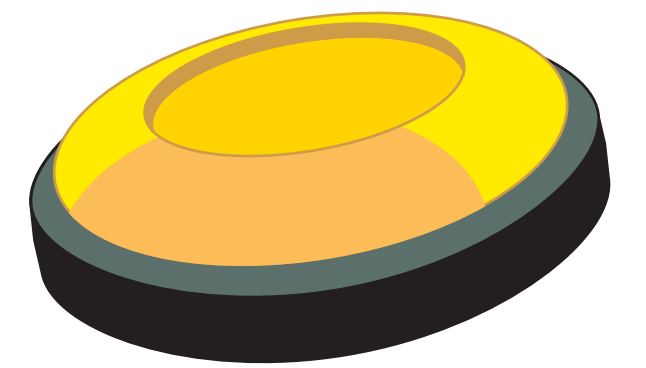
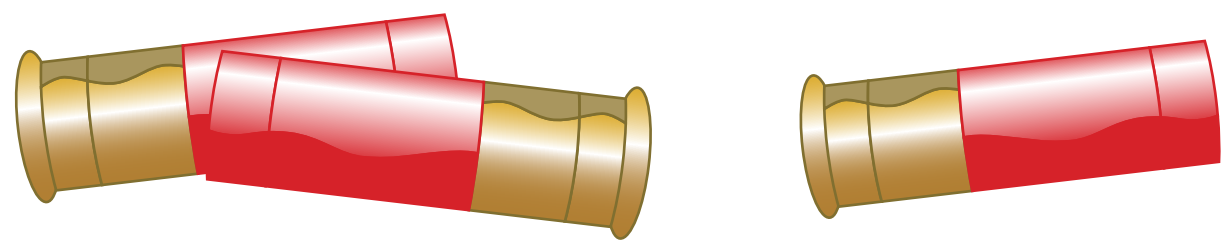


# **Joint Base Lewis - McChord Shotgun Shooting Complex Range Safety Rules**



- 1. Active Duty Military in Uniform have first priority in using ranges.**
- 2. Keep action of your gun open, except when it is your turn to fire.**
- 3. Never load a shell into any part of your gun, until you are on your post or station.**
- 4. Never load more than 2 shells on all stations. except station 8, which is 1 shell.**
- 5. Always direct your gun pointed down range in a safe direction.**
- 6. Do not move from post to post or station to station with a shell in any part of your gun.**
- 7. Always stay clear of target windows and trap machines. Only employees are authorized in machine houses.**
- 8. Be observant of others on the ranges and be courteous and show good sportsmanship at all times.**
- 9. No more than 6 shooters per squad.**
- 10. Pick up your hulls, boxes and other trash.**
- 11. When all ranges are being used and shooters are waiting to shoot, the one round rule is in effect.**
- 12. SMOKING/CHEWING TOBACCO is not allowed on the range.**
- 13. Authorized shot size – #7.5, 8, 8.5, 9 lead shot w/ 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" shell size ONLY. NO STEEL shot, 3" or 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" shot shells.**
- 14. Dog owners are responsible for controlling their pet. Scoop the poop.**
- 15. EYE AND EAR PROTECTIONS ARE REQUIRED.**
