



EFMP Enrollments

Required for active duty and Voluntary for Guard & Reserves on active orders.

• Ensures service members are assigned to installations where their dependent has access to specialty care i.e. PCS

• Not required to access health care for any military connected family. Tricare authorizes health care for all beneficiaries.

EFMP Family Support Services

Available to all National Guard & Reserve families on active orders.

• Supports families with access to care, IEP/504 school support, respite, recreation and community support.

 \cdot Enrollment is not required, only a copy of active orders.

Benefits of EFMP Enrollment

To access ECHO-related services:

A. EFMP Enrollment

1. Request medical provider complete an EFMP Medical Enrollment, DD Form 2792 with their condition(s) and ECHO related needs specifically noted.

2. Send the completed DD Form 2792 to Madigan EFMP Group Mailbox: <u>usarmy.jblm.medcom-mamc.mbx.efmp@mail.mil</u>

3. HRC NG/ AGR POC notifies the service member of the completion, consisting of a memo regarding their enrollment status and a certified copy of DD Form 2792.

B. Tricare Requirements

One must be on active orders for a period of more than 30 days Reference. Tricare Operations Manual Part 199.5 (ECHO) b.1.

C. ECHO Registration Referral for ECHO related services.

1. The service member provides the certified copy DD Form 2792, EFMP Medical Enrollment, received from HRC NG/AGR to Tricare ECHO, see site for fax.

2. Service Member identifies they will only have the certified copy because they are Guard or Reserve and request to waive the EFMP Enrollment Summary requirement. (Enrollment Summary comes only from the active duty PERNET).
