Registration can now be completed at 3 locations on JBLM- the Lewis Main Visitor's Center, McChord Field Visitor's Center, and now at the Bldg. 100 Customer Service Mall on McChord Field. Military ID cardholders who do not register in AIE will continue to be admitted at the gate, but will need to wait for security personnel to hand-scan their card before the barrier is raised when the AIE system is in use.
