Operation Clean-Up

Ongoing: JBLM Police Abandoned Vehicle Section locates and identifies abandoned and illegally parked vehicles (POVs, boats, RVs, etc.)

Upon identification, abandoned vehicles are issued a DD Form 2504 (Abandoned Vehicle Notice). Attempts to contact the owner or unit are made prior to any impoundment action. Unit CSMs are key in this process.

Operation Clean-Up Vehicle Removal:

On 15 October, vehicles that are inoperable, pose environmental hazards, or have failed attempts to contact, owners no longer assigned to JBLM, no DOL records, no registration, or expired plates, are removed from JBLM same-day.





Establishing a DS LOGON is essential to access your MHS GENESIS Patient Portal.

Ways to get a DS Logon.

The MHS GENESIS Patient Portal is a secure website for 24/7 access to your health information, including requesting appointments and exchanging messages with your care team at Madigan

1. Create a Premium DS Logon:

https://patientportal.mhsgenesis.health.mil

Click on "Need an account?"



You will need your **DoD ID number** and your **Social Security Number**. Your DoD ID number is located on your military ID card or you can visit the nearest DEERS office or Madigan primary care clinic and ask a staff member to assist you.

Once registered, go back to the homepage and select "Upgrade To Premium Account" to create a Premium Account (there is no cost associated with upgrading to a "Premium Account").

- You will be asked a series of personal identifying questions.
- · You will be asked to create a password, valid for 180 days.

2. Sponsor Request for Spouse DS Logon:



- Military sponsors (active duty and retired) can request a DS Logon for their spouse by logging in with a valid CAC or MyPay account username and password.
- Click "Register DS Logon for my Dependents" and complete the prompts.
- A PIN will be sent by mail to the spouse within 7-12 business days.



MHS GENESIS Patient Portal Dashboard



1. What is the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal?

The MHS GENESIS Patient Portal provides access to your EHR and contains your most current medical and dental information via a secure website. It connects you to your MTF's healthcare team and is available anytime, anywhere you have internet access, and provides a complete view of your and your family's health records.

2. How will I benefit from the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal?

The MHS GENESIS Patient Portal securely connects you with your healthcare team and empowers you to become the driver of your healthcare. With the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal you can:

- · Manage primary care medical and dental appointments
- · Review clinical notes, lab and test results
- · Request prescription renewals

o Renewals occur when a prescription has no refills left, or has expired, and the beneficiary needs to continue taking the medication. In this case, MTF staff evaluates and creates a new prescription, if appropriate.

- o New prescription renewals are done only through MHS GENESIS
- · Exchange secure messages with your healthcare team

It is important for you to maintain current contact info! Your election office needs your current contact information to reach you come election time. The most efficient way is to complete a Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) annually, with every change of address and at least 90 days prior to the election you want to vote in. That way your election office knows you want to register in that state, how to reach you and most importantly where to send your ballot!




