Key Points

- SLOW DOWN!!!
- Different than other winter weather regions
- Black Ice: shaded areas, even if air temp above freezing
- Caution on hills, curves, and traffic circles
- Gates: ice + congestion = accidents
- Limit driving during snow removal operations
- Stick to primary roads for safety





OPEN ENROLLMENT

TRICARE Open Season is the annual period when you can enroll in or change your health plan for the next year. The 2019 TRICARE Open Season begins on Monday, November 11th and ends on Monday, December 9th.

OPEN ENROLLMENT

During TRICARE Open Season, you can:

Do nothing: You'll continue in your current health plan through 2020 or as long as you're eligible.

Enroll in a plan: If you're eligible for a **TRICARE Prime** option or **TRICARE Select** but not enrolled, you can enroll in a plan now.

Change plans: If you're already enrolled in a TRICARE Prime option, or TRICARE Select, you can switch plans and switch between individual and family enrollment.

During TRICARE Open Season, you can:

Enroll into US Family Health Plan: For ADFMs, Retirees and their Familes. PACMED clinics are the contracted healthcare providers. For more information, call 1-888-958-7374 or visit www.usfhp.com

Qualifying Life Event: A QLE is a certain change in your life, such as marriage, birth of a child, or retirement from active duty, which may mean different TRICARE options are available to you. A TRICARE QLE opens a 90-day period for you to make eligible enrollment changes.

(BOOKING)

- Verifying <u>All</u> information on your paperwork is correct <u>BEFORE</u> signing
 - Name MUST match orders or amendments
 - Dates requested are <u>NOT</u> guaranteed until contacted by Transportation Service Provider **counselors DO NOT confirm dates**
 - Shipping documents <u>MUST</u> be signed or shipment will <u>NOT</u> be processed **DD1299 Application for Shipment and Storage / DD1797 Counseling Checklist**
- Provide any and all current contact information
 - Emails/phone numbers/in transit information (must have both military & personal emails)
- Releasing and Destination agents
 - Releasing/destination agents act on your behalf if you are not available for any reason **Add designated person on your DD1299 to authorize**
 - You must authorize this person being listed on the orders is not sufficient

STORAGE MANAGEMENT

(NTS & SIT)

- Non-Temporary Storage (Long Term Storage)
 - Overseas length of tour
 - Retirement 1 year only (no extensions for storage)
 - Separating 6 months only (no extensions for storage)
- Storage in Transit (Temporary storage)
 - Initial 90 days authorized for HHG Shipments for military members
 - <u>Must</u> apply for additional 90 days by contacting JPPSO-NW Storage Management <u>PRIOR</u> to storage expiring
 Emails MUST include justification for additional storage and supporting documentation
 - Additional storage requests are <u>NOT</u> guaranteed . Approvals can take time so submit **30 days** prior to expiration if possible
- Provide <u>ANY</u> contact information to avoid converting to your expense
 - Emails/phone numbers/in transit address


