I-5 (Stage-2) JBLM Main/North To Gravelly Lake



Issue: I-5 project goals: To relieve chronic traffic congestion and improve person and freight mobility along I-5 in the vicinity of Joint Base Lewis-McChord while maintaining access to the communities and military installations neighboring the highway.

Background/Discussion:

- ✓ \$495M State funded project to widen I-5 from 3 lanes to 4 lanes in both direction, construct above grade rail road crossing at Thorne, Berkeley, and DuPont, and construct a non-motorized path connecting Tillicum to DuPont. Note: At grade crossing at 41 Div. to remain as is.
- ✓ Schedule:
 - Stage-1. Center Dr. to Mounts Rd. FY17-FY18 (complete)
 - Stage-2. Thorne Ln. to 41 Div. FY18-FY21 (underway)
 - Stage-3. 41 Div to Center Dr. (FY21-FY25 (design)
 - Stage-4. Tillicum to DuPont. (FY22-FY24) (TBD)

Phase-2 will be complete 1st Qtr FY21
 Phase-3 construction to start 3rd Qtr FY21

Election Year 2020 Guidance



"... We uphold DoD's longstanding tradition of remaining apolitical as we carry out our official responsibilities. Maintaining the hard-earned trust and confidence of the American people requires us to avoid any action that could imply endorsement of a political party, candidate or campaign ..."

Mark T. Esper, Secretary of Defense Feb. 5, 2020

Military members **MAY**:

- Display political bumper stickers on their POV (one per candidate)
- Place a campaign sign in the yard of their <u>off-base</u> residence. <u>None on-base</u>
- Contribute (\$\$) to a campaign off-duty; but not at work, and not using govt. resources
- Express personal opinions about candidates or issues when off-duty (but *do not use your govt. position or title*)
- Attend, but not be an active participant, of a political event when off-duty and not in uniform

Military members **MAY NOT**:

- Display large political sign, banner or poster on their POV
- Engage in partisan political activities or campaigning
- Make a campaign speech or distribute campaign literature
- Organize a political rally or fundraiser
- Serve on a phone bank
- Share social media posts (Facebook, Twitter, etc.) from campaigns or political parties

Election Year 2020 Guidance



Additional Guidance:

- Military or civilians may wear political candidate's campaign t-shirt, button, hat, etc., on base as long as they're not actively campaigning, on duty, or in uniform (i.e., at Commissary, Exchange, Madigan, Armed Forces Day, Freedom Fest, etc.)
- No campaign signs on JBLM (other than a political bumper sticker), and no distribution of political literature by JBLM personnel or campaign staff on base
- Civilian DoD employees may participate in certain political activities, but the extent and nature of their participation is limited by the Hatch Act and DoD policy
- Although civilian employees may engage in political activity, they may never engage in such activity while on-duty, in a Federal building, or with the use of government resources, such as equipment (computers, printers, etc.)
- Service members and Department of Defense civilians are encouraged to exercise their right to vote and participate in our political process within the bounds of existing laws, regulations, and policies

The permitted and restricted behavior described on these slides is not an exhaustive list, and personnel should consult their servicing Judge Advocate with any questions



Attention TRICARE beneficiaries: It's covered!*

If you use TRICARE Prime or any other TRICARE plan, you may visit any TRICARE-authorized network urgent care center for urgent care.*

Urgent care is care you need for a non-emergency illness or injury requiring treatment within 24 hours. Examples of urgent care conditions include a sprain, rising temperature or sore throat. It isn't an emergency and doesn't threaten life, limb or eyesight.

*Madigan's enrolled Active Duty Family Members, Retirees, and Retirees Family Members are authorized to visit a TRICARE-authorized network urgent care center for acute care, no PCM referral required!



Moving Out of On-Base Housing



✓ Timely Notice

- ✓ If you do not have orders but know you are leaving contact your Housing District office in your neighborhood
- ✓ As soon as you have orders, notify your Housing District office and schedule an appointment to submit your move out notice

✓ Written Notice to Lincoln (Must be at least 30-days prior to moving out)

- ✓Bring your orders
- ✓ READ the move out packet that will be given to you
- $\checkmark \mathsf{Ask}$ questions and be sure you understand what is expected
- ✓ Schedule your **pre-inspection** and **final move out** appointment
- ✓ Sign a Notice to Vacate (NTV) Form with your Housing District Office

Have a specific concern? You may request a government quality assurance representative be present during your final inspection by contacting the DPW Housing Branch at (253) 967-2524.





Key and Essential Moving Survey



- Lincoln District Managers conducts a survey for Key and Essential assigned to Broadmoor, Westcott and Meriwether Landing Annually
 - Survey results help project availability and wait times for inbound Key and Essential personnel
- Residents will be emailed a survey link from the District Manager
- Survey is 4 questions and takes about 2 minutes to complete

STORAGE MANAGEMENT (NTS & SIT)

U.S.A.F.

- Non-Temporary Storage (Long Term Storage)
 - Overseas length of tour
 - Retirement 1 year only (no extensions for storage)
 - Separating 6 months only (no extensions for storage)
- Storage in Transit (Temporary storage)
 - Initial 90 days authorized for HHG Shipments for military members
 - <u>Must</u> apply for additional 90 days by contacting JPPSO-NW Storage Management <u>PRIOR</u> to storage expired
 - Additional storage requests are <u>NOT</u> guaranteed. Approvals can take time we request for **30 days** prior to expiration if possible
- Provide <u>ANY</u> contact information to avoid conversion of property.
 - Emails/phone numbers/in transit address





Warrior Adventure Quest (WAQ)

- Army Outdoor Recreation program through MWR
- Provides Service Members w/high-adventure activities during the duty day to boost resilience & support readiness
- Designed to introduce redeployed Service Members to adrenaline-pumping activities as alternatives to potentially destructive behaviors
- Now caters to troops in training: Beneficial for those preparing for/returning from deployment
- Sharpens outdoor skills to assist with mission readiness
- Provide alternatives to high-risk behaviors during off-duty time
- Combines events such as paintball, mountain biking, climbing, paddling, mountaineering & whitewater rafting with resilience & readiness training, & leader-led after action debrief (L-LAAD), developed by Army medical professionals
