Driving Directions

From I-5:

Take exit 125. Enter JBLM McChord Field. Take the first right turn down Fairway Drive after entering the gate, keep straight ahead, stop at the stop sign at Fairway Road and Lincoln, and then proceed straight ahead to the Escape Zone, Bldg. 841.

From the Barnes Gate:

Enter JBLM McChord Field. Turn left onto Lincoln Street. Immediately after crossing the railroad tracks, turn left down a tree lined road. Follow the road to the Escape Zone, Bldg. 841.

The free program offers parents and their children ages newborn to 5 yrs. a chance to participate in learning activities and socialize with other military Families and children.

The play place has age appropriate indoor and outdoor toys. During inclement weather we play inside in our two rooms stocked with fun toys. On sunny days we go outside and play on safe, child-sized playground equipment. We even have a fenced in yard where children can practice bike riding!
