General Questions

1 Who is responsible for, and decides upon, the lights in the Lincoln neighborhoods? With the winter coming and less light, some neighborhoods have some pretty dark areas.

There are two ways we install/maintain lighting on base. First, Lincoln Military Housing owns all the lighting in the residential areas on base. For the rest of the base, we have a contract with City Light & Power who installs and maintains the lights. We've recently conducted a combined drive around with Directorate of Public Works, our lighting contractor, and Lincoln Military Housing.

We have already installed lighting in some areas; such as Carter Lake Elementary, some neighborhoods, and some main avenues. We've also identified additional areas where it's needed, some just last night in the Town Hall. We appreciate people giving us those ideas. We're going to look at the ones between the Child Development Centers on McChord Field and Eagleview neighborhood, in addition to the ones we've already identified.

2 How can we find out when the ramps for I-5 are closed at the Main Gate? Can a marquee be set up before you exit the gate?

Ramp closures, dates, and times are posted on the <u>Washington State Department of</u>
<u>Transportation website</u>. Most of the work is being done at night or in the early morning hours.

There are a few additional ways to find out about closures. One is to sign up for email/text updates at https://public.govdelivery.com/accounts/WADOT/subscriber/new They will send you regular communication about when these closures are happening and where. You can also download the WSDOT app from Google Play or the App Store, and add the areas you typically travel to "My Routes", where you can check them frequently for updates.

DPW will try to work with the contractor to see if a marquee can be set up at the Liberty or Madigan Gates (JBLM Main), but we cannot guarantee the ability to do so. Information changes so frequently, we recommend checking the website or app for the most up to date information.
