	Scope	Access to behavioral health appointments can up to 30-45 days to initiate care (i.e., intake surveys and set-up for next appt.) for Service members and Family members to be seen for mental health issues not associated with suicide or Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). This long wait time may escalate to more serious issues that could have been treated initially; instead of reactive behavioral health care to preventative behavioral health care.				
	Recommendation	Establish same day appointments for behavioral health concerns for Service members and Family members.
