- WEAR HUNTER ORANGE or Hunters Pink at least 400 Sq. inches at all times while down range

- If you are returning after dusk call the police desk to let them know so they do not come looking for you.
- You are allowed on base 2 hours before daylight and 2 hours after daylight.
- No outdoor rec-cards are required for use of the Palouse to Cascades Trail
 (P2C) or for use of the Juvenile Fishing Pond (youth 14 years & younger)
- No mountain biking or horseback riding down range restricted to P2C.
