Dec. 3: Intro to Climbing

6–8 p.m. Meet at AU (\$25) ♦

This course provides a comprehensive introduction to top-rope climbing including how to secure a harness, tie-in as a climber, complete the proper system checks and communicate with your climbing partner. Also learn how to belay (manage the rope in order to keep the climber safe), catch a fall and lower your climber back to the ground.
