Materials Provided:

- (1) one plywood sheet measuring 4-by-8 feet
- (2) two 2-by-4's for standing supports

Schedule:

- Materials can be picked up starting 3 NOVEMBER
- All cards must be installed and displayed by 1 DECEMBER

Rules:

- Each participating unit may submit ONE card
- Cards are typically hand painted or decorated by service members, families, or base organizations
- Max dimensions 4-by-8 feet

Messaging:

- Must include unit name/Insignia and a holiday greeting
- Artwork and wording must be appropriate and respectful (no profanity, crude imagery, political statements, or religious preselecting)
- Use of official emblems, seals, or trademarks must follow Command policy

Colors/Material/ Safety:

- Paint must be non-hazardous/outdoor grade
- No exposed wiring or active lighting

Placement:

- Cards must be placed in approved locations
- Units must install (and remove later) their own cards, following time window set by DFMWR

Judging:

- Judging criteria: creativity, holiday spirit, workmanship, and overall impact
- Winners for Army and Air Force will be announced at the Holiday Tree Lighting Ceremonies
